Classifications (Levels) and Eligibility Rules:

An athlete may enter as many levels as desired; however, once the maximum number of wins has been earned in a level, the athlete may no longer compete in that level and must only enter in higher levels from that point on.

This is based on the honor system. Please keep track of your wins. Records should be maintained separately for each event.

Wins from other twirling organizations apply.

1st Contest: A contestant may only enter once in a lifetime

Novice (Nov): No longer eligible once athlete has won this event 1 time

Beginning (Beg): No longer eligible once athlete has won this event 5 times at any level

Intermediate (Int): No longer eligible once athlete has won this event 10 times at any level

High-Intermediate (for Solo event): No longer eligible once athlete has won the solo event 12 times at any level

Advanced (Adv): Open to all athletes, no maximum on number of wins

ESSENTIALS EVENTS:

The Competitive Achievement System (CAS) is a progressive skill development system, organized into a series of levels of achievement. CAS events emphasize technique, self-achievement, and the logical progression of skills. CAS events include: Compulsories (twirling skills), Movement Technique (body skills), Rhythm Twirl (combination of dance and twirling), Body Forms (poses blended with simplistic body movements), and Standard Solo (standardized routine). Athletes may receive comments or be evaluated (eval). The progression of levels (L) is: C - B - BI - BII - A - AA - AAA - Elite. Evaluation classifications are: Training I - Training II - Pass - Graduation - Honors. Athletes must receive at least a Pass to advance to the next level. For official evaluation, athlete must present CAS Record Book at contest; otherwise, only comments will be provided.
