It started with only 5 little girls who were interested in learning how to twirl.: two of them were their daughters Olivia and Julianna. First lessons were given in their garage! After a year, more girls joined them, and now, in their 6th year, they have

20 members.

Their members are divided between 2 teams, a beginner's class and individual classes. Next to baton twirling classes, they also give Acrobatics classes (new this year!). These classes help their competitive athletes to become stronger and more flexible. They perform at local and regional contests, and take part in a least 2 parades per year.

In the short time of their existence, they have had several local and regional successes. Some of their individual members were even able to win several National titles. Nore than this, they are having a lot of fun with their little club, and this year they are hosting their very first competition!

NTA's future plans include: implementing a logical baton development plan for our students, performing in Disneyland, taking one of their teams and more of their individual athletes to Nationals, and opening up a FULL TIME studio for baton, acrobatics and dance.
